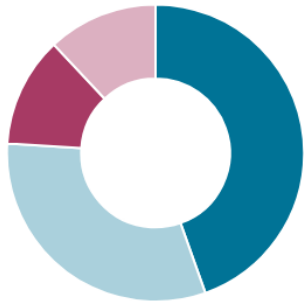

 - Operate machines to clean and blow-dry fur garments
 - Operate machines to dry-clean, dye, spray, re-oil, and re-buff suede and leather garments.
