Provide pre-hospital emergency medical care to patients with injuries or illnesses and transport them to medical facilities for further care.



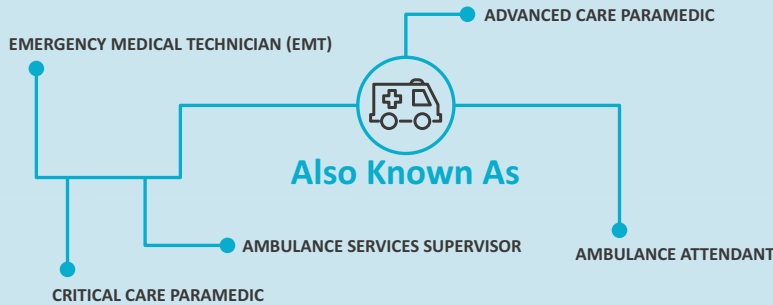

Assess, diagnose and treat psychological, emotional and behavioural disorders. They also research and apply theories relating to behaviour and mental processes.



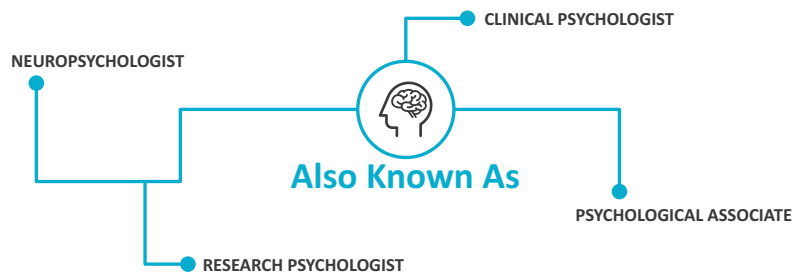

Prepare and dispense prescribed medications and advise patients how to use them. They also answer questions regarding the use of non-prescribed medications.



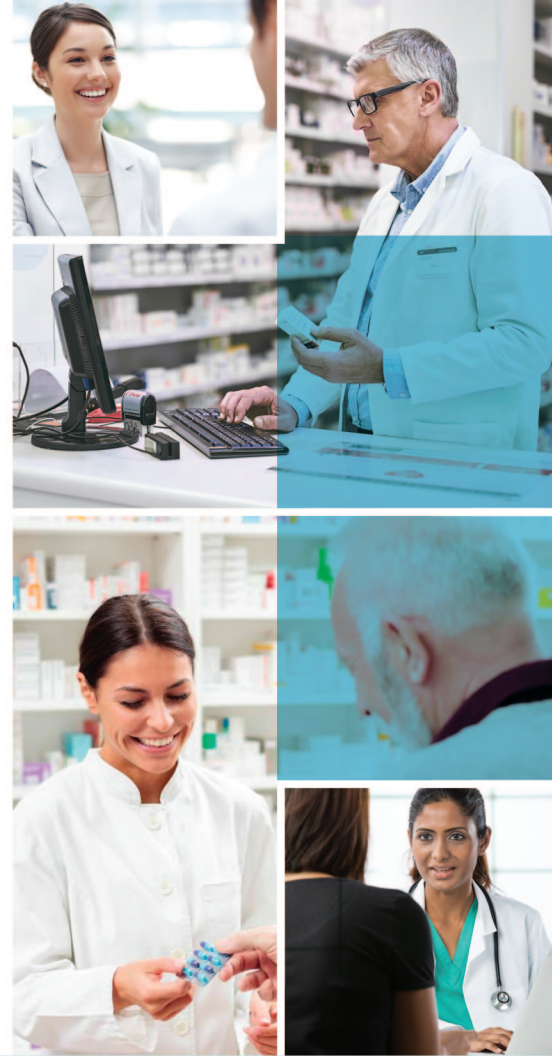
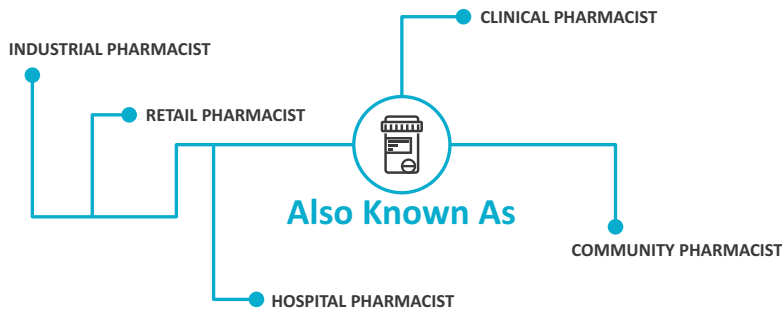

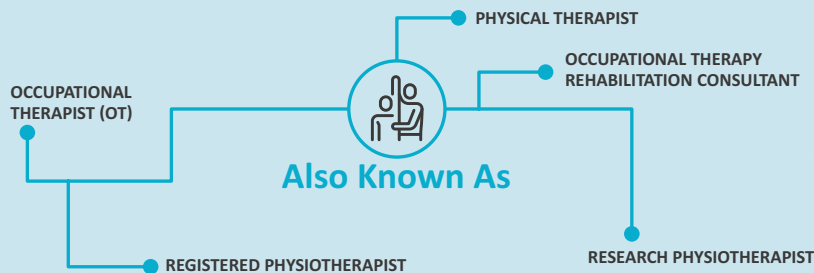
