OCCUPATION**



An occupation that has been designated under the *Apprenticeship and Occupational Certification Act* of New Brunswick.



**COMPULSARY
OCCUPATION**



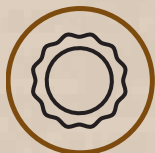
An occupation where an individual must meet requirements as specified under the Act in order to legally work (e.g. registered apprentice, certified journeyman, etc.).



**VOLUNTARY
OCCUPATION**



An occupation where an individual can legally work without meeting the requirements as specified for compulsory occupations.



**RED SEAL
ENDORSED**



A Red Seal endorsement indicates that a certified worker has demonstrated the competency in the full scope of their occupation and is recognized in all 13 provinces and territories in Canada.

Install and repair electrical systems designed to provide heat, light, power, control or alarms for all types of buildings and structures.



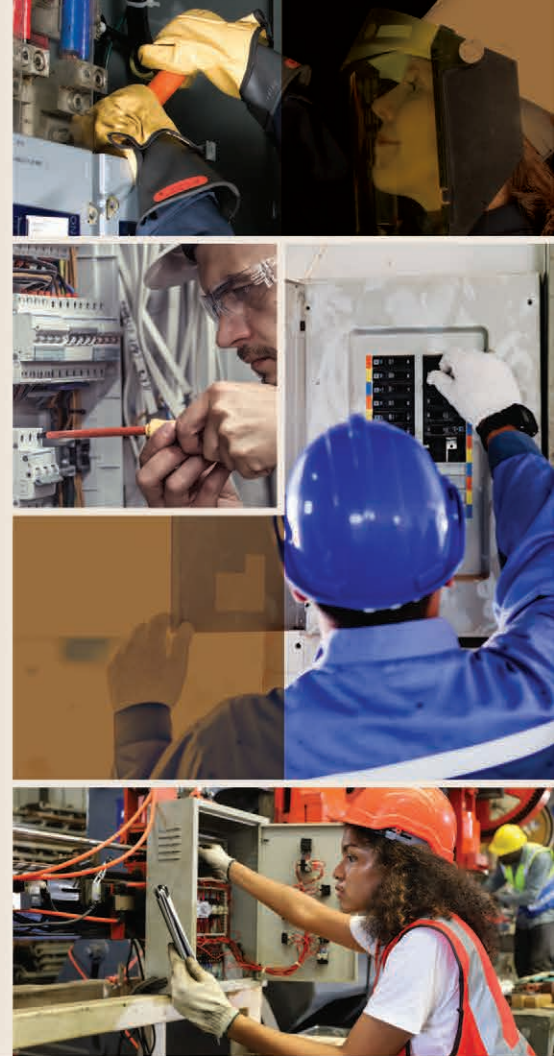
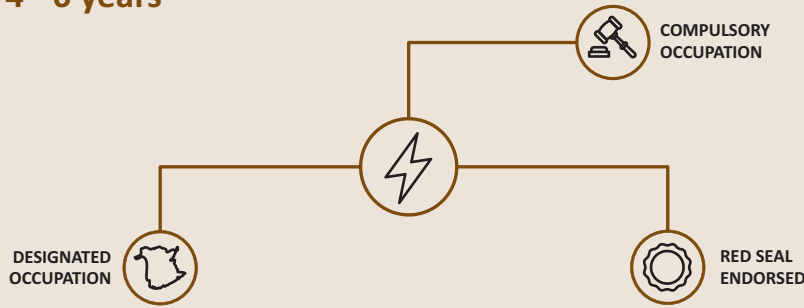

Install and repair pipes and other plumbing equipment used for water distribution and waste water disposal in all buildings.



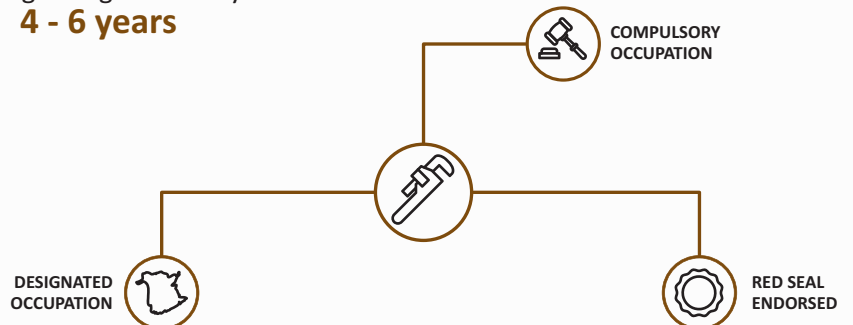

Construct, install and repair structures and components of structures made of wood, wood substitutes, lightweight steel and other materials.



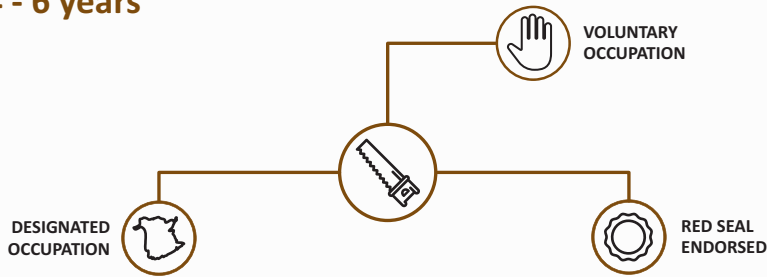

Lay bricks, concrete blocks, stone and similar materials to construct or repair walls, chimneys, fireplaces and other structures.



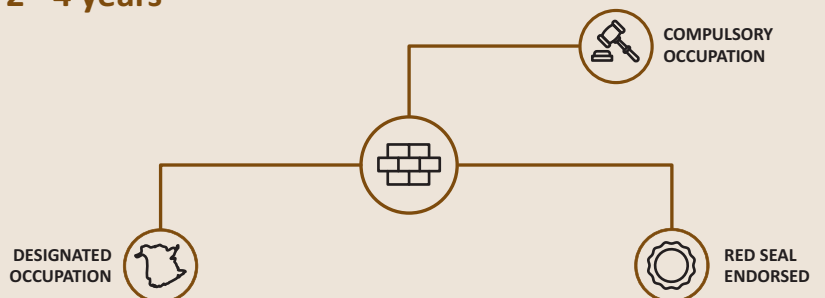

Assist skilled tradespersons and perform labouring activities at construction sites, in quarries and in surface mines.



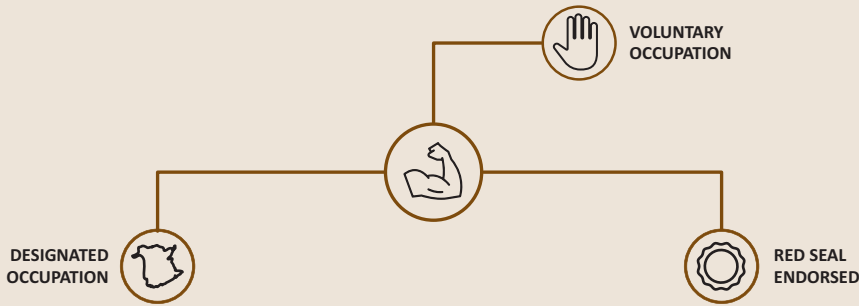

Use a variety of welding processes to join metal. They work in many industries, including construction, manufacturing and industrial repair.



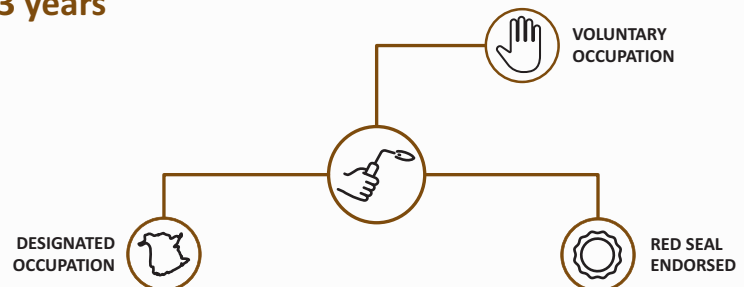
