













Provide professional nursing services, deliver health education programs and provide consultative nursing services to promote, maintain and restore patient health.






Combined occupations include Nursing coordinators and supervisors as well as Registered nurses and registered psychiatric nurses




Licensed Practical Nurses (LPN)

Provide care for individuals, families and groups in a variety of health care settings as part of a multidisciplinary team or under the direction of a Registered Nurse or medical practitioner.



Medical Specialists

Specialists in clinical and laboratory medicine diagnose and treat diseases and physiological or psychiatric disorders and act as consultants to other physicians. Specialists in surgery perform and supervise surgical procedures.







Are registered nurses with additional education and a specialty of practice. They may work independently or with physicians and other health-care providers to deliver preventive and continuous health care to patients.








Family Physicians
